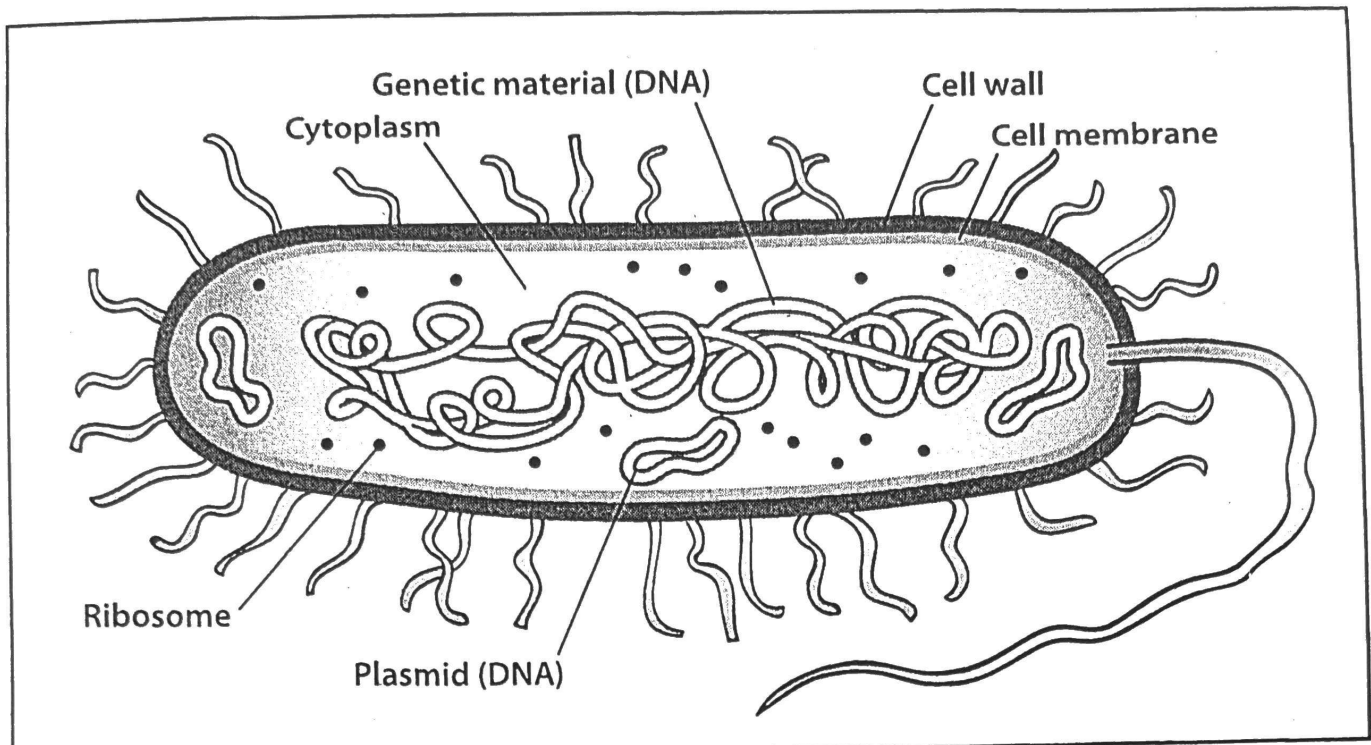


Bacterial Cell Structures and Functions



Cell structure	Function
	Boundary that controls what enters and leaves the cell
	A rigid layer that supports the cell and provides shape
	Internal fluid that contains the cell structures
	A molecule that determines the nature of cell structures and substances
	Small piece of genetic material that is independent of other DNA in the cell and that can be passed to other bacteria
	A structure that makes proteins, in the cytoplasm
