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## Interactive Science Notebook Guidelines

*Notebooks MUST be brought to class every day!*

*Pages must be numbered correctly and assignments must be completed on the correct page.*

*Include a title on every page in your notebook.*

*“LEFT side/reflection” pages are your response to the learning.*

*Choose activities that are meaningful to you.*

*\*\*Teacher assigned at the beginning of school.*

*\*\*Must show an understanding/extension of the learning.*

*Use pencil to write all text and initial sketches.*

*This allows you to erase mistakes.*

*Do not use pen or colored pencils to write text or for initial sketches.*

*Do not use markers to color directly onto notebook pages.*

*(Markers bleed through the paper.)*

*\*\*Markers may be used on foldables, handouts, worksheets etc.*

*Use color - the notebook is a visual study tool! Color should be meaningful; helping to organize and illustrate your notes.*

*(Highlighters come in handy here!)*

*If you are absent from class, check the board to see what you have missed! You are responsible for the work.*

Notebook Organization:

RIGHT SIDE IS FOR LEARNING (notes, vocabulary, labs, investigations, etc...)

LEFT SIDE IS FOR REFLECTION (creative, diagrams, pictures, colorful drawings, etc...)
