

More than half, but less than fully illuminated

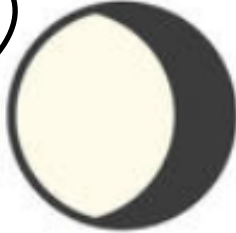


GIBBOUS

QUARTER

To decrease gradually in size, the illuminated part of the moon is becoming smaller



One half of the moon (facing the Earth) appears to be illuminated.

CRESCENT

The moon's unilluminated side is facing Earth



Having concave and convex edges terminating in points

To increase gradually in size, the illuminated part of the moon is getting bigger
